It's this added refuge from the constant stress of their daily lives that is so appreciated by group members. People like John, a regular visitor at our Drop-In, who attends the Men's Group to relax in the company of friends.

For many, living on the streets or living in poverty means being invisible. No one looks at you when they walk past. No one listens when you speak. But at ehm, everyone is welcomed. Staff get to know clients and greet them by name. As clients grow more comfortable, they can begin to identify goals with staff, whether it's seeking better housing or improving their health.

But it all starts with a conversation, and a warm, welcoming place to catch your breath and unwind. A place like the Men's Group.


